We will have an opportunity to learn or relearn what we should know...it will help us to help others learn about the Catholic Church and grow closer to our Lord, Jesus.

The sessions will take place on Tuesday evenings, every other week, they are informal, no pre-registration is needed, drop-in as your schedule allows, a study guide is provided; we will have a question box for questions directed to Fr. Girotti at the end of the 15 sessions, and a free-will offering will be available to offset the cost of the DVDs.

Generally, each session will begin with a sign-in, the DVD presentation, and after the video, a short Question and Answer/Discussion period as needed. The sessions usually last about 1 hour with a ½ hour discussion period if needed.
