Divine Mercy

This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a time to reflect on Jesus' great mercy given to all of us. There is no way we can earn it! It is a gift!

This is a little of the life story of Saint Faustina who is known as the *Apostle of Divine Mercy*. She was born Helenka Kowalski in Poland in 1905. She was the third of ten children. Her father was a carpenter and a peasant. The family was poor and religious. She stated that she first felt a calling to religious service while attending the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at the age of seven. She wanted to enter a convent when she had finished her schooling, but her parent said no. At the age of 16, she went to work as a housekeeper to help support herself and help her parents. After working a year, twice she asked her parent's permission to join a convent but was met with a firm refusal.

At the age of 19, she had a vision of the suffering Jesus and was told by Jesus to leave for Warsaw and join a convent. She packed a bag and left without her parent's permission.

After much searching, she was accepted at the convent of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Through the years she had many visions of Jesus and was asked by her Spiritual Director to write a diary recording her conversations and messages from Jesus. She also wrote a Chaplet and the Novena of Divine Mercy.

Sister Faustina died of tuberculosis on October 5, 1938, 13 years after entering the convent. She was declared a Saint on April 30, 2000 – the first saint of the 21st century. She now rests at the Basilica of Divine Mercy in Krakow, Poland.
